

**Avery Eloffson** is a Senior Assistant District Attorney and has been with the Office of the District Attorney since 2008. He handles complex litigation such as data breach, frauds, piracy, counterfeit, elder abuse, multi-defendant cases, and homicides. In 2016, Avery was put in charge of the Consumer Protection Division for the Office where he was responsible for all civil litigation, settlements, and public relations. After building up the division and obtaining over one million dollars in judgments, Avery returned to full-time criminal prosecution in 2021. Avery has prosecuted nearly 1,700 matters, made approximately 3,000 court appearances, and tried over 50 felony cases. Avery graduated law school in 2008 from Chicago-Kent, where he received the Dean's Distinguished Public Service Award and was both the Student Bar Association's (Evening Division) Vice President and the Hispanic Law Student Association's President. Avery works throughout the community by presenting on public safety issues such as elder abuse and is also on the F.A.S.T. Team.
